\$1 Million Winning Powerball Ticket Sold in Seymour *Lucky ticket purchased at Seymour BP*

MADISON, Wis. – If you bought a [Powerball](#) ticket in Seymour for the Wednesday, September 29, drawing, you could be a millionaire. A \$1 million ticket was sold yesterday at the **Seymour BP**, 234 N. Main St. The ticket matched all five numbers – 2-7-11-17-32 but not the *Powerball* number of 11. The jackpot is now estimated at \$620 million for the Saturday, October 2, drawing.

Seymour BP is not unfamiliar with million-dollar tickets. The Lottery retailer sold a \$1 million top prize Million Fortune scratch ticket in January of 2020. Seymour BP owner, Janardan Bhandari, stated, "I'm very happy to sell another million-dollar winning ticket."

Wisconsin Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets over \$599 receive a 2% incentive. For selling the \$1 million *Powerball* ticket, BP Seymour will receive \$20,000 as part of the Retailer Performance Program Winning Ticket Incentive.

The Seymour BP \$1 million ticket was the fourth winning *Powerball* ticket of \$1 million or more in Wisconsin in 2021.

Nationally, there were a LOT of big winners in the Wednesday, September 29, *Powerball* drawing:

- 5 winning *Match 5* tickets – \$1 million (CA, FL, IN, NY, WI)
- 3 winning *Match 5 + Power Play* tickets – \$2 million (MI, OH, OK)
- 19 winning *Match 4 + PB + Power Play* – \$150,000
- 77 winning *Match 4 + PB* – \$50,000

The Saturday, October 2, drawing will be the **40th draw** in this jackpot run. If won, it would be the 6th largest jackpot in *Powerball* history and 10th largest jackpot in U.S. Lottery history.

The odds of winning the \$1,000,000 *Powerball* prize for matching 5 of 5 numbers are 1 in 11,688,054. The odds of winning the *Powerball* jackpot are 1 in 292,201,338 million.

Powerball drawings are Mondays, Wednesdays, and Saturdays at 9:59 p.m. Tickets must be purchased before 9 p.m. on to be included in that day's drawing. *Powerball* tickets are \$2 per play with the option to purchase the *Power Play* feature for an additional dollar which could increase potential winnings.
