Winning Powerball Tickets Sold in Minocqua, Kenosha and Menasha *Jackpot rolls to \$230.0 Million*



(Madison) — Wisconsin had two \$40,000 winning tickets and one \$10,000 winning ticket in the Wednesday, January 21 Powerball drawing.

All three tickets matched four out of five numbers and the Powerball, which pays out a \$10,000 prize. In addition, the tickets sold in Minocqua and Kenosha had the Power Play option, which multiplied the prize by 4, resulting in a \$40,000 win.

One \$40,000 Powerball ticket was sold at Trig's Food & Drug, 70 West Shopping Center in Minocqua.

The second \$40,000 Powerball ticket was sold at Stinebrink's Kenosha Foods, 7600 Pershing Boulevard in Kenosha.

The \$10,000 Powerball ticket was sold at U.S. Oil Company, 700 3rd Street in Menasha.

Wednesday's winning Powerball numbers were 11, 12, 15, 28, and 57 with a Powerball of 23. The Power Play number was 4. The Powerball jackpot is estimated at \$230.0 million (\$157.8 million cash) for the Saturday, January 24 drawing.

Power Play is a feature of Powerball that gives winners a chance to multiply their prizes for an additional \$1 for each set of Powerball numbers they purchase. After each Powerball drawing, a Power Play number from 2 to 5 is drawn. With a Power Play purchase, prizes from \$4 to \$10,000 are multiplied by the selected Power Play number. The \$1,000,000 prize automatically becomes a \$2,000,000 prize with the addition of Power Play, regardless of the multiplier number that is drawn.

Winners at all prize levels have 180 days to validate their tickets by mail or in person at the Lottery's Madison or Milwaukee offices.
