Stanley Man Claims \$1 Million Powerball Prize



(Madison) — Robert Bogard of Stanley became Wisconsin's newest millionaire when he claimed his winning Powerball ticket yesterday afternoon at the Lottery office in Madison.

Bogard purchased his ticket at Stanley Travel Stop, 600 South Broadway Street in Stanley. After taxes, Bogard will receive \$673,498.65.

Bogard has agreed to take part in a news conference on Thursday in Stanley.

The winning Powerball numbers for October 18, 2014 were 20, 26, 27, 36 and 54. The Powerball was 19. The \$1 million prize is for matching all five regular numbers, but not the Powerball number. The odds of winning \$1 million in Powerball are approximately 1:5.16 million.

For selling the \$1 million winner, Stanley Travel Stop earns a \$20,000 commission from the Lottery. Retailers who sell winning tickets with prizes of \$600 or more earn a commission equal to 2% of the prize, up to a maximum of \$100,000.
