\$41,000 Badger 5 Ticket Sold in Germantown

Second jackpot ticket this week from the same store



(Madison) — One ticket sold in Germantown matched all five winning numbers in the Wisconsin Lottery's Thursday, October 2, Badger 5 lotto drawing to claim the night's \$41,000 prize.

The \$41,000 winning ticket was sold at Pick'n Save, N112 W16200 Mequon Rd. in Germantown.

This makes the second Badger 5 winning ticket sold at this Pick'n Save this week: the store was one of two that split a \$60,000 jackpot in Monday's drawing, for \$30,000 each.

The ticket-holder has 180 days to claim the prize at the Lottery's Madison or Milwaukee offices, or by mail.

Thursday night's winning Badger 5 numbers were 1, 5, 10, 28 and 31.

Badger 5 is a \$1 daily lotto game with jackpots that start at \$10,000 and grow a minimum of \$1,000 a day until they are won. Players win the rolling jackpot by matching their five numbers to the five winning numbers drawn each night.

The odds of winning the Badger 5 jackpot are approximately 1:170,000.
