## **\$1 Million Powerball Prize Claimed by Group in Green Bay**



(Madison) — A group of nine co-workers that reside in Brown County have come forward to claim a \$1,000,000 winning Powerball ticket from August 27.

The winners are: Richard Jurgens of Green Bay; Sara Kennedy of Abrams; Jennifer Lange of Two Rivers; Beth Lyman of Maribel; Sarah Perera of Green Bay; Glenna Pupp of De Pere; Eric Raabe of Green Bay; Margaret Szczepkowski of Green Bay; and Lisa Witkowski of Green Bay. All nine winners will receive \$111,100 before taxes.

The winning ticket was purchased at Festival Foods, 2534 Steffens Ct. in Green Bay. For selling the \$1 million winner, Festival Foods earns a \$20,000 commission from the Lottery. Retailers who sell winning tickets with prizes of \$600 or more earn a commission equal to 2% of the prize, up to a maximum of \$100,000.

The winners have agreed to take part in a news conference on Tuesday in Green Bay.

The August 27 winning Powerball numbers were 17, 24, 26, 45, and 46. The Powerball was 19. The \$1 million prize is for matching all five regular numbers, but not the Powerball number. The odds of winning \$1 million in Powerball are approximately 1:5.16 million.
