## **Five Consecutive Numbers Drawn in Badger 5 Drawing** *\$53,000 jackpot split by two tickets in historic draw*



(Madison) — On Monday night, five consecutive winning numbers were drawn in the nightly Badger 5 drawing. This is the first time consecutive numbers have been drawn in Badger 5 since the game started more than 11 years ago.

Although not drawn in sequential order, Monday night's winning numbers were **8, 9, 10, 11 and 12**.

One ticket sold in Greenfield and one sold in North Fond du Lac matched all five winning numbers in the drawing to split the \$53,000 prize. The tickets, worth \$26,500 each, were sold at:

**Speedway**, 4265 S. 60<sup>th</sup> Street, in Greenfield, and  
**PDQ Food Store**, 400 Prospect Road, in North Fond du Lac.

The ticket-holders have 180 days to claim the prize by mail or in person at the Lottery's Madison or Milwaukee offices.

Badger 5 is a \$1 daily lotto game with jackpots that start at \$10,000 and grow a minimum of \$1,000 a day until they are won. Players win the rolling jackpot by matching their five numbers to the five winning numbers drawn each night. If more than one ticket matches all five winning numbers, the jackpot is split evenly by all tickets matching all five numbers.

Badger 5 was first offered in Wisconsin in February 2003. The odds of winning the Badger 5 jackpot are approximately 1:170,000. The odds of five consecutive numbers being drawn are approximately 1:6,797.
