Wisconsin Has Powerball Winners – Players Should Check Tickets ***\$1 Million Powerball Ticket Sold in Racine***

(MADISON) — One lucky Wisconsin player is holding a winning \$1,000,000 ticket from the Wednesday, February 11 *Powerball* drawing. Five other players also won big: a second player won \$30,000 and four additional players each won \$10,000 in last night's drawing. Wednesday's winning *Powerball* numbers were 11, 13, 25, 39, and 54, with a Powerball of 19. The Power Play number was 3.

- **The \$1,000,000 *Powerball* ticket was sold at Durand Avenue Mart – 3900 Durand Avenue in Racine.** The winner matched five out of five numbers, but not the Powerball.
- **The \$30,000 winner purchased their *Powerball* ticket at Bob's Mini Mart – 506 Ohio Street in Oshkosh.** The \$30,000 winner matched four out of five numbers and the Powerball. They also purchased the Power Play option which multiplied their \$10,000 winnings by 3.
- The \$10,000 winners matched four out of five numbers and the Powerball. **The \$10,000 *Powerball* winning tickets were purchased at:**
 - **Express Mart – 126 Spring Street in Blair**
 - **Kwik Trip – 108 West Bridge Street in New Lisbon**
 - **Lieungh's on Lathrop – 1933 Lathrop Avenue in Racine**
 - **Jandu Petroleum – 1767 Egg Harbor Road in Sturgeon Bay**

Winners at all prize levels have 180 days to claim their prize by mail or in person at the Lottery's Madison or Milwaukee offices.

The next *Powerball* drawing will be held on Saturday, February 14. That jackpot is estimated at \$40.0 million (\$27.0 million cash).



The odds of winning the \$1 Million prize are 1:5,153,633. The odds of winning the \$10,000 prize are 1:648,976.
