Powerball Jackpot Keeps Rolling; Two Tickets Split \$25,000 Badger 5 Jackpot!



(Madison) — There were no Powerball jackpot winners last night in any state. The Powerball jackpot remains untouched and grows to \$330 million (\$189 million cash). However, Wisconsin still saw some big winners on Wednesday night, with two lucky tickets splitting the \$25,000 Badger 5 jackpot!

The two winning Badger 5 tickets are each worth \$12,500. Wednesday night's winning Badger 5 numbers were 8, 13, 17, 19 and 29. The tickets were sold at:

- AKA Station at 3 W. Union Avenue in Cedar Grove
- SSG Holiday at 314 E. Badger in Waupaca

The next Powerball drawing will be on Saturday night at 9:59 p.m.

Ticket holders at all prize levels have 180 days from Wednesday's drawing to claim their prizes.

Power Play is a feature of Powerball that gives all winners a chance to multiply their prizes for an additional \$1 for each set of Powerball numbers they purchase. After each Powerball drawing, a Power Play number from 2 to 5 is drawn. With a Power Play purchase, prizes from \$4 to \$10,000 are multiplied by the selected Power Play number. The \$1,000,000 prize automatically becomes a \$2,000,000 prize with the addition of Power Play, regardless of the multiplier number that is drawn.

Badger 5 is a \$1 daily lotto game with jackpots that start at \$10,000 and grow a minimum of \$1,000 a day until they are won. Players win the rolling jackpot by matching their five numbers to the five winning numbers drawn each night.
