Two Rivers Man Claims SuperCash! Top Prize


November 16 drawing produces \$350,000 winner

A Two Rivers (Manitowoc County) man claimed the **SuperCash!** top prize on November 20. **William Junk** won \$350,000 by matching the numbers 4, 8, 11, 24, and 27 in the November 16 daily drawing.

Junk purchased his ticket at the Manitowoc Mini Mart (808 Memorial Drive). The win marked the game's second top prize claimed in the month of November.

Retailers who sell winning tickets over \$599 receive an incentive of 2% of the winning ticket amount up to \$100,000.
