## Waterloo Man Claims \$350,000 SuperCash! Prize



(Madison) —Juan Villegas of Waterloo has claimed a \$350,000 prize in the Wisconsin Lottery's SuperCash! daily lotto game.

Villegas bought his lucky ticket for the Saturday, April 12th drawing at Landmark Services Cooperative, 510 W. Main Street, Marshall. The ticket matched all six winning numbers (03, 22, 24, 34, 36 and 39) and won the SuperCash! top prize of \$350,000.

After taxes, Villegas received a lump sum payment of \$235,725.13.

This is not Villegas' first big win. On October 25, 2006 Villegas won the \$28,000 Badger 5 jackpot. Landmark Services Cooperative seems to be lucky for Villegas, as this ticket was also purchased there.

For selling Villegas his winning SuperCash! ticket, Landmark Services Cooperative earns a \$7,000 commission from the Lottery. Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets with prizes of \$600 or more earn the equivalent of 2% of the prize, up to a maximum commission of \$100,000.

SuperCash! is a daily lotto game played only in Wisconsin. Players try to match the six winning numbers drawn each night from a field of 39 numbers for a chance to win prizes of \$1, \$30, \$500, and the top prize of \$350,000. There is also a doubler feature at no additional cost. When the doubler is drawn, every prize, excluding the top prize, doubles.

The odds of winning the SuperCash! \$350,000 top prize are approximately 1:1.6 million.
