Thiensville Man Claims 5 Card Cash Top Prize



(Madison) — Terence Gengler has claimed the \$250,000 top prize in the Wisconsin Lottery's 5 Card Cash lotto game for his ticket purchased on Friday, June 13, 2014.

Gengler became the second 5 Card Cash top prize winner in the game's history after purchasing his ticket at Thiensville Self Serve, 301 N. Main St. in Thiensville. The ticket matched all five winning card symbols (2 of Clubs, K of Spades, Queen of Diamonds, 6 of Hearts, and King of Diamonds) and won the top prize of \$250,000.

Because Gengler's ticket had two Kings, he also won \$2 on the instant portion of the ticket.

For selling Gengler the winning ticket, Thiensville Self Serve earns a \$5,000 commission from the Lottery. Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets with prizes of \$600 or more earn the equivalent of 2% of the prize, up to a maximum commission of \$100,000.

5 Card Cash is the Wisconsin Lottery's new daily lotto game which offers two ways to win. When players buy their ticket, five card symbols are printed on it. If the five card symbols include a pair of 8's or better or a higher winning hand, like three of a kind, a flush or a full house, they win instantly. The top prize on the instant portion is \$5,000 for having a royal flush.

For the nightly drawing, the lottery draws five random card symbols from the 52 total cards. A player then wins if they match at least two of the five cards drawn. If they match all five, the player wins \$250,000!

The odds of winning the 5 Card Cash \$250,000 top prize are approximately 1:2.6 million.
