Wautoma Man Claims Top Prize in Instant Million Game

(Madison) — Joel Jarvis of Wautoma has come forward as the latest millionaire from the Wisconsin Lottery's \$30 instant ticket, Instant Million.

Joel bought his ticket at Family Fil, W7711 Hwy 21 in Wautoma. He will take home \$673,507.50 after taxes. Condon Oil, which owns and operates Family Fil, also operates Ultimate Citgo West in Ripon, which sold the first Instant Million top prize in February of this year.

For selling the \$1 million winning ticket, Family Fil earns a \$20,000 incentive. Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets with prizes of \$600 or more earn the equivalent of 2% of the prize, up to \$100,000.

Joel is a long-time Lottery player who says he buys Lottery tickets every day, when he also buys a soda for his wife. Joel declined to hold a news conference.

Instant Million launched in February 2014 with four top prizes of \$1 million. Joel is the last top prize winner in the game, with \$1 million prizes having been claimed previously in Ripon, Milwaukee and Black Earth.

The new \$30 ticket Super Millions, also with \$1 million top prizes, will be taking the place of Instant Million. Super Millions started last Friday, and no top prizes in the game have been claimed yet.
