5 Card Cash Top Prize Claimed by Pewaukee Woman



(Madison) —Shirley Hall of Pewaukee took her place in Wisconsin Lottery history yesterday when she claimed her \$250,000 prize in the Wisconsin Lottery's 5 Card Cash daily lotto game. Hall was the first top prize winner in the new game, which started in Wisconsin on April 6.

Hall became the first 5 Card Cash top prize winner on June 2, 2014, after purchasing her ticket at Franksville Oil & LP Gas, 10616 Highway K, in Franksville. The ticket matched all five winning card symbols (3 of Spades, Queen of Hearts, King of Diamonds, Queen of Diamonds and Queen of Clubs) and won the top prize of \$250,000.

Because Hall's ticket had three Queens, she also won \$5 on the instant portion of the ticket.

For selling Hall her winning ticket, Franksville Oil and LP Gas earns a \$5,000 commission from the Lottery. Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets with prizes of \$600 or more earn the equivalent of 2% of the prize, up to a maximum commission of \$100,000.

5 Card Cash is the Wisconsin Lottery's new daily lotto game which offers two ways to win. When players buy their ticket, five card symbols are printed on it. If the five card symbols include a pair of 8's or better or a higher winning hand, like three of a kind, a flush or a full house, they win instantly. The top prize on the instant portion is \$5,000 for having a royal flush.

For the nightly drawing, the lottery draws five random card symbols from the 52 total cards. A player then wins if they match at least two of the five cards drawn. If they match all five, the player wins \$250,000!

The odds of winning the 5 Card Cash \$250,000 top prize are approximately 1:2.6 million.
