## **\$50,000 Powerball Winner Sold in Saint Francis** *Power Play Turns \$10,000 Win Into \$50,000!*



(Madison) — While nobody in any state won the Powerball jackpot in the Wednesday, August 6 drawing, one Wisconsin Lottery player did win big with the Power Play multiplier option.

The ticket sold in Milwaukee County matched four out of five numbers and the Powerball, which pays out a \$10,000 prize. In addition, the winner purchased the Power Play option, which multiplies the prize by 5, resulting in a \$50,000 win.

**The \$50,000 winning ticket was sold in Saint Francis at Pick'n Save, 4698 S. Whitnall Ave.**

Wednesday's winning Powerball numbers were 01, 08, 24, 28, and 49 with a Powerball of 24. The Power Play number was 5. The Powerball jackpot climbs to an estimated \$90 million (\$54.0 million cash) for the Saturday, August 9 drawing.

Power Play is a feature of Powerball that gives all winners a chance to multiply their prizes for an additional \$1 for each set of Powerball numbers they purchase. After each Powerball drawing, a Power Play number from 2 to 5 is drawn. With a Power Play purchase, prizes from \$4 to \$10,000 are multiplied by the selected Power Play number. The \$1,000,000 prize automatically becomes a \$2,000,000 prize with the addition of Power Play, regardless of the multiplier number that is drawn.

Winners at all prize levels have 180 days to validate their tickets.
