A Lucky Night for Three Powerball Players in Wisconsin

Powerball Jackpot Estimated at \$53 Million for Saturday

Wisconsin had three lucky players in the Wednesday, October 31 *Powerball* drawing. Each player matched four out of five numbers plus the *Powerball* which earned them each the \$50,000 prize. But, because one player also purchased the Power Play prize multiplier feature, that \$50,000 prize was automatically multiplied by three. Power Play turned the \$50,000 winner into a \$150,000 winner.

The winning numbers from the Wednesday, October 31 drawing were 07, 25, 39, 40, and 47. The *Powerball* was 20 and the Power Play number was 3.

The winning tickets were sold at:

- Kwik Trip #389 at 108 West Madison Street in Eau Claire (Eau Claire County) - \$150,000 winning ticket
- Eddies Convenience Store at 9860 State Highway 21 East in Sparta (Monroe County) - \$50,000 winning ticket
- Kwik Trip #864 at 2807 Tower Avenue in Superior (Douglas County) - \$50,000 winning ticket

Winners at all prize levels have 180 days from the drawing to claim their prizes. Winners of more than \$599 must claim their prize at the Lottery's Madison or Milwaukee office or by mail.

The next *Powerball* drawing will be Saturday, November 3. The estimated jackpot is \$53 million (\$30.5 million cash).

How to Play

- Plays cost \$2 each
- Tickets must be purchased by 9 p.m. to be included in the drawing
- Choose five numbers between 1 and 69 and one Powerball number between 1 and 26
- Sign your ticket and check it as soon as possible to avoid missing out on any prize you may have won



The odds of winning the \$50,000 prize are 1:913,130.
