Barron County Player Holds \$50,000 *Powerball* Ticket *Powerball Jackpot at \$307 Million for Wednesday*

One lucky Wisconsin player is holding a \$50,000 winning *Powerball* ticket from the Saturday, August 5 *Powerball* drawing.

The lucky winner purchased their ticket at Bob & Steve's BP Amoco Shop at 1633 Superior Street in Cumberland.

The winner matched four out of five numbers plus the *Powerball*. Saturday's winning *Powerball* numbers were 11, 21, 28, 33 and 45 with a *Powerball* of 11. The Power Play number was 2.

Winners at all prize levels have 180 days from the drawing to claim their prizes.

Winners of more than \$599 must claim their prize at the Lottery's Madison or Milwaukee office or by mail.

The next *Powerball* drawing will be Wednesday, August 9. The estimated jackpot is \$307 million (\$193.2 million cash).

HOW TO PLAY

- Plays cost \$2 each
- Tickets must be purchased by 9 p.m. to be included in the drawing
- Choose five numbers between 1 and 69 and one *Powerball* number between 1 and 26
- Sign your ticket and check it as soon as possible to avoid missing out on any prize you may have won



The odds of winning the \$50,000 prize are 1:913,130.
