## Franklin Man Claims \$50,000 Powerball Ticket

David O'Neill of Franklin was one of three lucky players who matched four numbers plus the *Powerball* in the Wednesday, November 23 *Powerball* drawing to win \$50,000. O'Neill purchased his ticket at Speedway at 10001 West Church Street in Franklin.

Purchasers of the other two winning tickets were:

- Mark Turner of Hudson purchased his ticket at Trego Travel Center at W5741 County Highway E in Trego
- Thomas McIlquham of Altoona purchased his ticket at Kwik Trip at 2929 Meadowlark Lane in Altoona

The winning numbers from the Wednesday, November 23 drawing were 7, 32, 41, 47, and 61 with a Powerball of 3. The Power Play number was 2. Winners at all prize levels have 180 days from the drawing to claim their prizes.

## **How to Play**

Tickets must be purchased by 9 p.m. on Wednesday and Saturday to be included in the drawing:

- Each ticket costs \$2 per play
- Choose five different numbers 1-69 and one Powerball number 1-26
- Sign your ticket and check it as soon as possible to avoid missing out on any prize you may have won

While the jackpot gets the most attention, there are other prizes to be won in *Powerball*. Prizes range from \$4 for matching just the *Powerball* to \$1 million for matching all five numbers (but not the *Powerball*). For an extra \$1 per play, you can choose Power Play to increase your non-jackpot winnings which will be multiplied by the drawing's Power Play number. For example, if your prize is \$50,000 and the Power Play number is 5, you win \$250,000 just by adding Power Play. The \$1 million prize automatically becomes \$2 million with Power Play.



The odds of winning the \$50,000 prize are 1:913,130.
