Iowa Resident Claims \$50,000 *Powerball* Ticket

An Iowa man has won \$50,000 from a *Powerball* ticket he purchased in Wisconsin.

Thomas Wiemerslage of McGregor Iowa was the lucky player who matched four numbers plus the *Powerball* in the Saturday, January 21 *Powerball* drawing to win \$50,000.

Wiemerslage purchased the ticket at Krachey's BP at 1910 South Marquette Road in Prairie du Chien.

The winning numbers from the Saturday, January 21 drawing were 23, 25, 45, 52, and 67 with a *Powerball* of 2. The Power Play number was 2. Winners at all prize levels have 180 days from the drawing to claim their prizes.

How to Play

Tickets must be purchased by 9 p.m. on Wednesday and Saturday to be included in the drawing:

- Each ticket costs \$2 per play
- Choose five different numbers from 1 to 69 and one *Powerball* number from 1 to 26
- Sign your ticket and check it as soon as possible to avoid missing out on any prize you may have won

While the jackpot gets the most attention, there are other prizes to be won in *Powerball*. Prizes range from \$4 for matching just the *Powerball* to \$1 million for matching all five numbers (but not the *Powerball*). For an extra \$1 per play, you can choose Power Play to increase your non-jackpot winnings which will be multiplied by the drawing's Power Play number. For example, if your prize is \$50,000 and the Power Play number is 5, you win \$250,000 just by adding Power Play. The \$1 million prize automatically becomes \$2 million with Power Play.



The odds of winning the \$50,000 prize are 1:913,130.
