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## Menomonie Woman Wins \$50,000 in *Powerball*

Leslie Sailer of Menomonie is one of two lucky players who each won \$50,000 from the Wednesday, September 27 *Powerball* drawing. The other player who has already claimed his prize was Steven Boyer of Spring Valley. Both tickets matched four out of five numbers plus the *Powerball*.

The lucky players purchased their tickets at:

- Sailer purchased her ticket at Kwik Trip at 2008 Stout Road in Menomonie (Dunn County)
- Boyer purchased his ticket at Team Oil at W2555 State Road 29 in Spring Valley (Pierce County)

The winning numbers from the Wednesday, September 27 drawing were 8, 10, 21, 23, and 25. The *Powerball* was 22 and the Power Play number was 3.

The next *Powerball* drawing is Saturday, October 21. The estimated jackpot is \$173 million (\$109 million cash). Tickets must be purchased by 9 p.m. to be included in the drawing.

### How to Play

- Each ticket costs \$2 per play
- Choose five different numbers from 1 to 69 and one *Powerball* number from 1 to 26
- Sign your ticket and check it as soon as possible to avoid missing out on any prize you may have won

While the jackpot gets the most attention, there are other prizes to be won in *Powerball*. Prizes range from \$4 for matching just the *Powerball* to \$1 million for matching all five numbers (but not the *Powerball*). For an extra \$1 per play, you can choose Power Play to increase your non-jackpot winnings which will be multiplied by the drawing's Power Play number. For example, if your prize is \$50,000 and the Power Play number is 5, you win \$250,000 just by adding Power Play. The \$1 million prize automatically becomes \$2 million with Power Play.



*The odds of winning the \$50,000 prize are 1:913,130.*

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
