Five Reasons to Play Wednesday's *Powerball* Jackpot

Below are the five reasons to purchase a ticket for Wednesday night's *Powerball* drawing, which is at an all-time high of \$1.4 billion or an estimated \$868 million cash payout:

1. You have better odds of winning *Powerball* than the Minnesota Vikings do of winning the Super Bowl this year.
2. You can turn a \$2 ticket into \$1.4 billion. That means you could buy everyone in Wisconsin a fish fry for the next 22 Fridays.
3. For the next 96 years, you could buy a brat for everyone in a sold-out Miller Park for every home game (yes, even Cubs fans).
4. If you won \$1.4 billion, you would be able to purchase enough gallons of milk to fill the Wisconsin State Capitol dome 78 times.
5. You'll be contributing to the \$3.87 billion plus that has been generated in property tax relief for Wisconsin homeowners.

How To Play

Tickets must be purchased by 9:00 p.m. to be included in the Wednesday, January 13 drawing. Each ticket costs \$2 per play. You choose five different numbers 1-69 and one Powerball number 1-26. Be sure to sign your ticket and check it as soon as possible to avoid missing out on any prize you may have won.



The odds of winning the Powerball jackpot are approximately 1:292.2 million.
