\$50,000 Powerball Winners Starting To Come Forward
Winning tickets redeemed from the \$1.5 billion dollar jackpot run

Wisconsin had a total of 22 Powerball winners from the January 9 and January 13 drawings. Each won \$50,000 and fourteen of the winners have come forward to claim their prize.

The estimated Powerball jackpot for the Wednesday, January 21 drawing is \$50 million (\$31.8 million cash). Tickets must be purchased by 9:00 p.m. on Wednesday to be included in the drawing:

- Each ticket costs \$2 per play
• Choose five different numbers 1-69 and one Powerball number 1-26
• Sign your ticket and check it as soon as possible to avoid missing out on any prize you may have won

The mission of Wisconsin Lottery is to provide property tax relief to Wisconsin homeowners. Since the sale of the first lottery ticket in September 1988, the Lottery has generated more than \$3.87 billion in property tax relief for Wisconsin homeowners, \$766 million in commissions for Wisconsin businesses, and more than \$7.14 billion in prizes for players.



The odds of winning the Powerball jackpot are approximately 1:292.2 million.
