Powerball Over Half Billion Dollars for Saturday

Players in Milwaukee, Taylor and Eau Claire Counties Hold \$50,000 Winning Powerball Ticket

The next *Powerball* drawing will be held on Saturday, August 19. That jackpot is estimated at \$510.0 million (\$324.2 million cash). This is the 20th drawing since the *Powerball* jackpot was last hit on June 10, 2017, and the 5th largest jackpot in the history of the game.

Three lucky Wisconsin players are holding a \$50,000 winning *Powerball* ticket from the Wednesday, August 16 *Powerball* drawing. All three tickets matched four out of five numbers plus the *Powerball*.

The lucky winners purchased their tickets at:

- Sentry at 6700 West State Street in Wauwatosa (Milwaukee County)
- Medford Cooperative at 160 Medford Plaza in Medford (Taylor County)
- Mega Holiday at 3702 Gateway Drive in Eau Claire (Eau Claire County)

The winning numbers from the Wednesday, August 16 drawing were 9 - 15 - 43 - 60 and 64. The *Powerball* was 4 and the Power Play number was 3.

Winners at all prize levels have 180 days from the drawing to claim their prizes at the Madison or Milwaukee office.

HOW TO PLAY

- Plays cost \$2 each
- Tickets must be purchased by 9 p.m. to be included in the drawing
- Choose five numbers between 1 and 69 and one *Powerball* number between 1 and 26
- Sign your ticket and check it as soon as possible to avoid missing out on any prize you may have won



The odds of winning the \$50,000 prize are 1:913,130.
