Powerball at \$650 Million for Wednesday

Player in Langlade County Holds \$200,000 Winning Powerball Ticket

Players in Oneida and Waukesha Counties Hold \$50,000 Winning Powerball Ticket

One lucky Wisconsin player is holding a \$200,000 winning *Powerball* ticket and two players are holding a \$50,000 winning *Powerball* ticket from the Saturday, August 19 *Powerball* drawing. All three tickets matched four out of five numbers plus the *Powerball*. The \$200,000 winner chose the Power Play option to increase the prize from \$50,000 to \$200,000.

The lucky winners purchased their tickets at:

- BP North at N4005 Highway 45 in Antigo (Langlade County) - \$200,000 winning ticket
- Krist Food Mart at 8650 Morgan Road in Minocqua (Oneida County) - \$50,000 winning ticket
- Quick Pick Food at 14001 West National Avenue in New Berlin (Waukesha County) - \$50,000 ticket

The winning numbers from the Saturday, August 19, *Powerball* drawing were 17, 19, 39, 43 and 68 with a *Powerball* of 13. The Power Play number was 4.

Winners at all prize levels have 180 days from the drawing to claim their prizes at the Madison or Milwaukee office.

The next *Powerball* drawing will be held this Wednesday, August 23. That jackpot is estimated at \$650 million (\$411.7 million cash). This is the second largest jackpot in *Powerball* game history and the third largest among lottery jackpots in North America.

"To put it in perspective, this Wednesday's jackpot is high enough to buy each Wisconsinite 25 bags of cheese curds – and still have about \$2.8 million left over," said Wisconsin Lottery Director Cindy Polzin. Pool play is very popular with big jackpots and reinforces the community aspect of playing *Powerball* with friends and coworkers. "While playing the Lottery is fun, we encourage our players to play responsibly."

HOW TO PLAY

- Plays cost \$2 each
- Tickets must be purchased by 9 p.m. to be included in the drawing
- Choose five numbers between 1 and 69 and one *Powerball* number between 1 and 26
- Sign your ticket and check it as soon as possible to avoid missing out on any prize you may have won



The odds of winning the \$50,000 prize are 1:913,130.
