Sheboygan Player Holds \$100,000 *Powerball* Ticket

Saturday's Powerball Jackpot Estimated at \$70 Million

One lucky Wisconsin player is holding a \$100,000 winning *Powerball* ticket from the Wednesday, August 21 *Powerball* drawing.

The winner matched four out of five numbers plus the *Powerball*. But, because they also purchased the Power Play prize multiplier feature, the \$50,000 prize was automatically multiplied by two. Power Play turned the \$50,000 ticket into a \$100,000 winner. Wednesday's winning *Powerball* numbers were 01, 07, 45, 47 and 69 with a *Powerball* of 13. The Power Play number was 2.

The lucky winner purchased their ticket at Minit Mart at 1006 Geele Avenue in Sheboygan. Winners at all prize levels have 180 days from the drawing to claim their prizes.

Wisconsin retailers who sell winning tickets over \$500 receive an incentive of 2 percent of the winning ticket amount up to \$100,000.

The next *Powerball* drawing will be Saturday, August 25. The estimated jackpot is \$70 million (\$42.2 million cash).

HOW TO PLAY

- Plays cost \$2 each
- Tickets must be purchased by 9 p.m. to be included in the drawing
- Choose five numbers between 1 and 69 and one *Powerball* number between 1 and 26
- Sign your ticket and check it as soon as possible to avoid missing out on any prize you may have won



The odds of winning the \$50,000 prize are 1:913,130.
