# Megabucks with Lightning Ball Debuts Today 

Limited time offer available throughout the month of February
MADISON, Wis. - The Wisconsin Lottery's Megabucks has a new addition for the month of February. Today through Feb. 28 , an extra number per play, known as the Lightning Ball, will be printed in addition to the usual six numbers on one in every three sets of two Megabucks plays statewide.

A Megabucks win matches at least three numbers in one play to the numbers drawn or during February, matches two numbers and the Lightning Ball to the numbers drawn. The Lightning Ball cannot be used to match and win the jackpot prize. However, players matching five-of-six numbers plus the Lightning Ball to the numbers drawn will win $\$ 10,000$. The new $\$ 10,000$ prize amount is only available for the Megabucks Lightning Ball limited time offer.

There is no additional player cost for the Lightning Ball offer, which is included in the standard Megabucks two plays for $\$ 1.00$. The odds of a set of two plays each receiving a Lightning Ball are one-in-three. The Lightning Ball counts for any drawing in which that same play is entered.


The odds of a set of two plays each receiving a Megabucks Lightning Ball is 1:3; The odds of winning the Megabucks jackpot is $1: 7$ million.
