## Jackpot Win Highlights Badger 5 Birthday Weekend

Saturday draw produces \$165,000 for ticket sold in Washington County

MADISON, Wis. - On the eve of its "sweet 16" birthday, the Wisconsin Lottery's Badger 5 game produced a jackpot winner. Saturday's draw won one lucky player \$165,000 on a ticket purchased in Jackson (Washington County). Badger 5, which debuted Feb. 17, 2003, celebrated its 16th birthday the following day.

The winning numbers of 4, 5, 8, 27, and 30 came from a ticket sold at East Side Mart (N168 W19490 Main St.) in Jackson. As the winning retailer, the store will receive a \$3,300 incentive based on two percent of the prize amount. The ticket holder has 180 days from the drawing date to claim their prize in person at the Lottery's Madison office.

The win marked the first \$100,000 Badger 5 prize of 2019. The odds of matching all five numbers to win the Badger 5 jackpot are 1 in 169,911.
