# Sheboygan Resident Claims \$1 Million Megabucks Jackpot Prize won in Feb. 9 drawing 

MADISON, Wis. - A Sheboygan resident claimed a $\$ 1$ million Megabucks prize Thursday in Madison. Mary Polster hit the jackpot in the Feb. 9 drawing.

Polster matched all six numbers drawn (9, 21, 26, 31, 35, and 47) on a ticket purchased at the Kwik Trip on 7002 Sauk Trail Rd. in Sheboygan. The store will receive a $\$ 20,000$ incentive based on two percent of the prize amount.

Thursday's claim marked the Lottery's second $\$ 1$ million prize payout in the past week. On Feb. 23, a $\$ 1$ million Powerball prize was claimed.

The odds of matching all six Megabucks numbers to win the jackpot are 1 in $6,991,908$.
