# Powerball Jackpot at $\$ 625$ Million, 4th-highest in History Saturday night draw could produce first winner of 2019 

MADISON, Wis. - At $\$ 625$ million, the current Powerball jackpot is fourth-largest in history. Saturday's drawing could produce the first winner of 2019.
"With yet another roll of Powerball, the jackpot is reaching historic levels," said Wisconsin Lottery Director Cindy Polzin. "Now fourth-largest, this run is starting to feel similar to the frenzy that we saw last fall. We want our players to be enthusiastic about the jackpot, yet still play responsibly."

Each of the top four all-time highest jackpots surpassed the $\$ 600$ million mark and came in successive years. The all-time record $\$ 1.586$ Billion was won in 2016 across three states (California, Florida, and Tennessee).

The current Powerball jackpot has rolled 24 times to reach its highest level in seven months since October's run reached $\$ 687.8$ million, third-most all-time.

Wisconsin has 16 jackpot wins since Powerball's inception in 1988. The state's most recent jackpot winner came exactly two years ago when a Milwaukee resident won $\$ 156.2$ million on March 22, 2017.

Powerball also features prizes ranging from $\$ 4$ to $\$ 1$ million. Wisconsin residents have won $\$ 50,000$ prizes in each of the past three drawings dating back to March 13.

- Plays cost $\$ 2$ each
- $\quad$ Players must purchase tickets by 9 p.m. Wednesday to be included in that night's drawing
- Choose five numbers between 1 and 69 and one Powerball number between 1 and 26
- Sign your ticket and check it as soon as possible to avoid missing out on any prize you may have won

The odds of winning the Powerball jackpot are 1:292.2 million.
