\$10,000 Mega Millions prize won just one mile from Powerball jackpot site

MADISON, Wis. – Friday's Mega Millions drawing produced New Berlin's second national game win in just three days. A prize of \$10,000 came on a ticket purchased just one mile from where Wednesday's Powerball \$768.4 million jackpot winner was sold.

A ticket sold at the Kwik Trip on 15700 W. Small Rd, in New Berlin, just a mile south on S. Moorland Rd, from the Speedway where the winning Powerball ticket was purchased, produced Friday's Mega Millions win.

With close proximity both in time and geographic location, New Berlin can lay claim to being Wisconsin's second miracle mile, a nickname given to Fond du Lac after its run of jackpot wins. Sheboygan also has a "lucky city" title in 2019 with a pair of Megabucks wins of \$5.9 million in January and \$1 million in February.

A lucky player matched 4 of 5 numbers plus the Mega Ball in Friday's Mega Millions drawing (5, 14, 15, 62, 66, Mega Ball 3) to win \$10,000. Odds of winning the prize are 1 in 931,002.

The winner has 180 days from the draw date to claim their prize in person or by mail through the Wisconsin Lottery's Madison office.
