5 Card Cash Lotto Game to Retire This Weekend

Final drawing scheduled for Saturday, April 6

MADISON, Wis. - The Wisconsin Lottery's 5 Card Cash Lotto game is retiring this weekend. The final drawing is Saturday, April 6 and the game will no longer be offered for purchase after that date. Prizes may still be redeemed up to 180 days after the draw date printed on the ticket.

Since debuting in April 2014, 5 Card Cash has paid out over \$18.5 million in prizes.

Game retirements allow the Lottery to introduce new, fun and engaging offerings that help maximize property tax relief for Wisconsin residents. The Lottery continually reviews its product lines and makes adjustments as needed based on data trends and feedback.

ABOUT THE WISCONSIN LOTTERY

The Wisconsin Lottery enriches communities statewide by giving back 93 percent of its revenue to winners, retailers, and Wisconsin homeowners. Of each dollar spent on the Wisconsin Lottery, 57 cents goes back to prizes, 30 cents to property tax credits, seven cents to operations and six cents to retailers. Since 1988, the Wisconsin Lottery generated:

- More than \$14.5 billion in total revenue
