New All or Nothing Game Debuts Sunday

Wisconsin Lottery launches first new Lotto game since 2014 this weekend

MADISON, Wis. – The Wisconsin Lottery makes history Sunday, April 7 when its new All or Nothing Lotto game launches. The state's first Lotto game since 2014, *All or Nothing* is a unique \$2 daily game where players can win the \$100,000 top prize by matching all 11 numbers or none of the 11 numbers.

"We are very excited about our launch of the new All or Nothing daily game," said Wisconsin Lottery Director Cindy Polzin. "There is always great anticipation for a new game and since this particular play style is something that we have not had before, it adds to the buzz around this launch."

Just as the game is titled, players can win the \$100,000 top prize by matching all 11 numbers or none of the 11 numbers. In total, there are eight ways to win a prize. Matching 10 numbers or one number wins \$500, matching nine or two numbers wins \$40, and matching eight or three numbers wins \$4. No prizes are won for matching four, five, six, or seven numbers.

HOW TO PLAY ALL OR NOTHING:

- 1. Choose eleven different numbers from 1 to 22.
- 2. Place wagers by asking for a QUICK PICK or by using the All or Nothing playslip. Playslips are available at Wisconsin Lottery retailers.
- 3. Choose how many draws to play. Each ticket costs \$2 per play per draw. All or Nothing can be played up to 7 draws in advance.
- 4. Check playslip carefully before handing it to the retailer. ALL OR NOTHING TICKETS CANNOT BE CANCELLED.
- 5. Give completed playslip and cash to the retailer.
- 6. Receive, sign, and safeguard ticket. A ticket is needed to claim a prize. Playslips are not valid to claim a prize.

ABOUT THE WISCONSIN LOTTERY
