Last Weekend in June Lottery Winners

Rolling into July with three lotto drawing prizes won

MADISON, Wis. – Wisconsin had another winning weekend with three respectable lotto drawing prizes hit.

One *Powerball* player matched 4 of 5 numbers to win the \$50,000 top prize. The winning ticket (13, 17, 24, 59 and 62) was purchased at Ayah Citgo Express (324 N. Main Street) in Fond du Lac.

Two lucky players won Badger 5's jackpot. The first player matched all five winning numbers (4, 6, 16, 19 and 25) from Friday's drawing, taking home \$25,000. The winning ticket was purchased at River Road BP (300 Third Street) in Pepin.

In Saturday's drawing the second lucky Badger 5 player matched 5 of 5 (4, 8, 24, 26 and 27) to win \$23,000. This ticket was purchased at Just Not Salt & Pepper (4162 S. 108 Street) in Milwaukee.

Odds of winning *Powerball's* \$50,000 prize are 1 in 913,130; the odds of winning the *Badger 5* jackpot are 1 in 169,911.
