Scratching the Way to \$1 Million

Lottery player claims Golden Millions top prize

MADISON, Wis. - It was a Golden Millions Monday as one lucky Wisconsin Lottery player scratched his way to a \$1 Million top prize.

John Clerigo of Merrillan won the \$1 Million Golden Millions top prize by scratching off 20 spots with a \$10,000 prize and "5X" symbol. After a sleepless night, Cierigo claimed his prize this morning at Lottery headquarters. He bought the winning ticket at Kwik Trip (15 County Road A) in Black River Falls.

Odds of winning the Golden Millions top prize are 1 in 160,000. There are no top prizes remaining.
