Holly Jolly Raffle 2020 Winner Claims \$100,000 Prize

Top prize-winning ticket purchased in Sparta

MADISON, Wis. - Sidney Hall Jr. of Wittenberg claimed the \$100,000 top prize in the Wisconsin Lottery's 2020 Holly Jolly Raffle. Hall purchased his winning ticket at Casey's General Store (326 S Black River St.) in Sparta.

Hall purchased several tickets for this year's Holly Jolly Raffle and plays this limited time, limited quantity lotto game every year. He plans to use some of his winnings to help friends and family members. The top prize-winning ticket number was 033052.

The 2019 Holly Jolly Raffle winning ticket was purchased at Holiday Station Store (4010 Marinette Ave.) in Marinette.

After popularity and fast sales in 2019, the Lottery added 25,000 additional tickets to this year's raffle along with over 500 more prizes. Holly Jolly Raffle launched on October 23 with a total of 125,000 tickets and sold out on November 28, 2020.

In addition to the \$100,000 top prize winner, a total of 65 tickets won prizes of \$1,000, while 1,500 others won \$100 apiece. Players can check their numbers at: wilottery.com/games/raffles or at any Lottery retailer.

Winners at all prize levels have until June 5, 2021 to claim their prize (180 days from the draw date). Visit wilottery.com/winners/claim-prize for details on claiming prizes. All winning tickets can be claimed by mail, or in person by appointment only. Appointments are only available at the Madison office and can be made by calling the Player Hotline at (608) 261-4916. The \$100 prize can be claimed at retailers.
