## Holly Jolly Raffle Winner Claims \$100,000 Prize

*Pump and Munch in Neenah sells winning ticket*

**MADISON, Wis.** – Elizabeth Sontag of Neenah is the winner of the Wisconsin Lottery \$100,000 [Holly Jolly Raffle](#) lotto game top prize. Purchased at the Pump N Munch, 101 E. Bell St., **Neenah**, Sontag claimed her big win after buying just one \$5 raffle ticket. The odds of winning the 2021 *Holly Jolly Raffle* top prize are one out of 125,000.

A long-time, well-liked lotto game, the Lottery first held the *Holly Jolly Raffle* in 2010, offering 50,000 total tickets. The limited time, limited quantity game has grown in popularity during its lifespan from 75,000 to 100,000 to now 125,000 available tickets.

Sontag's winning number of 006253 was drawn on December 6, 2021. The raffle was launched on Friday, October 22, 2021, and sold out on Friday, November 19, 2021 – seven days faster than the 2020 *Holly Jolly Raffle*.

In addition to the top prize-winner, 65 tickets of \$1,000 and 1,500 tickets of \$100 were also drawn. Players can check their numbers at any Lottery retailer or by going to [wilottery.com/games/raffles](http://wilottery.com/games/raffles).

Winners at all prize levels have until June 4, 2022, to claim their prize (180 full days after the drawing date). All winning tickets can be claimed by mail or in person at the Madison or Milwaukee offices. \$100 prize winners can be claimed at any retailer. Wisconsin Lottery retailers who sell winning lotto or scratch tickets over \$599 receive a two percent Retailer Performance Program Winning Ticket Incentive.

Prizes = 50.4% of sales. Odds based on 125,000 tickets sold.
