## Wisconsin Weekend Winners

## Winning lotto tickets sold in Delafield, Hustisford, and Twin Lakes

MADISON, Wis. - It was a hot weekend in Wisconsin for lotto players. Friday, a $\$ 100,000$ winning All or Nothing ticket was sold at the Walmart SuperCenter on 2863 Heritage Dr. in Delafield for the June 2, 2023, evening drawing. The winning ticket matched 11 of 11 numbers (1-4-5-7-8-10-11-12-14-15-17).

Saturday, two $\$ 50,000$ winning Powerball tickets were purchased for the June 3, 2023 drawing. One at Station Hustis on 326 W. Juneau St. in Hustisford and one at Berkot's Super Foods on 600 N. Lake Ave. in Twin Lakes. The winning tickets matched four of five numbers (15-45-64-67-68) plus the Powerball (18).

For Berkot's Super Foods, the win is all too familiar. It is the second time the Lottery retailer sold a winning $\$ 50,000$ Powerball ticket in less than three months. Berkot's Super Foods sold its first Powerball winning ticket for the March 22, 2023, drawing.

Wisconsin Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets over $\$ 599$ receive a two percent Retailer Performance Winning Ticket Incentive, up to $\$ 100,000$.

All or Nothing players can win the $\$ 100,000$ top prize by matching 0 of 11 numbers or by matching 11 of 11
 numbers. Drawings are held seven days a week, twice daily. Tickets must be purchased before 1:30 p.m. for the midday drawing and before 9:00 p.m. for the evening drawing. The odds of winning the $\$ 100,000$ All or Nothing top prize are 1 in 352,716.

Powerball drawings are Monday, Wednesday, and Saturday at 9:59 p.m. Tickets must be purchased before 9 p.m. to be included in a drawing. Powerball tickets are $\$ 2$ per play, with the option to buy the Power Play feature for an additional dollar. The odds of winning a $\$ 50,000$ Powerball prize are $1: 913,130$. The estimated Powerball jackpot for the Monday, June $5^{\text {th }}$ drawing is $\$ 269$ million. The odds of winning the Powerball jackpot are 1:292,201,338.
