## \$50,000 Powerball Winning Ticket Purchased in Eau Claire

Mega Holiday chain sells two \$50,000 winning Powerball tickets within five days
MADISON, Wis. - A \$50,000 Powerball winning ticket was sold at Mega Holiday on 6126 Texaco Dr. in Eau Claire for the Monday, June $12^{\text {th }}$ drawing. The winning ticket matched four of five numbers (2-3-16-23-68) plus the Powerball (7).

It is the second time in a week that a Mega Holiday location and a Powerball win are making news. On June $7^{\text {th }}$, a $\$ 50,000$ Powerball winning ticket was purchased at a Mega Holiday in Altoona.

Five big Powerball winning tickets have been sold in Wisconsin in June so far including:

Players have 180 days from the draw date to claim their

winnings. Information on how to claim a prize is available at wilottery.com/winners/claim-prize. All winning Lottery tickets need to be signed. Lottery tickets are bearer instruments; whoever signs the back of the ticket is considered the rightful owner.

Wisconsin Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets over \$599 receive a two percent Retailer Performance Winning Ticket Incentive, up to \$100,000.

The odds of winning a $\$ 50,000$ Powerball prize are $1: 913,130$ and the odds of winning a $\$ 1,000,000$ Powerball prize are 1: 11,688,054.

The estimated Powerball jackpot for the Wednesday, June $14^{\text {th }}$ drawing is $\$ 340$ million. The odds of winning the Powerball jackpot are 1:292,201,338.

Powerball drawings are Monday, Wednesday, and Saturday at 9:59 p.m. Tickets must be purchased before 9 p.m. to be included in a drawing. Powerball tickets are $\$ 2$ per play, with the option to buy the Power Play feature for an additional dollar.
