\$313,373 Fast Play Progressive Jackpot and \$100,000 All or Nothing Winning Tickets Sold on Tuesday

Big wins in Waukesha and Wauwatosa

MADISON, Wis. - Tuesday, June 13, 2023, went by fast for one player and was all good for another. A lucky \$10 50X Fast Play ticket won \$313,373, or 100% of the Fast Play Progressive Jackpot. The winning ticket was sold at Stone Ridge Mobil Mart on W240 N1485 Pewaukee Rd. in Waukesha. In the city of Wauwatosa, a winning \$100,000 All or Nothing ticket, matching 11 of 11 numbers, was sold at Tosa Mobil on 8806 W. North Ave. for the Midday drawing.

"All or Nothing is a popular game at our store," said Tosa Mobil Manager Dave Leach. "I'd love to congratulate the winner. Sounds like it's vacation time for them."

The \$100,000 winning Lottery ticket is the largest sold by Tosa Mobil in the last five years.

The \$313,373 Fast Play Progressive Jackpot adds to an already impressive big win history for Stone Ridge Mobil Mart. Since June 2018, the store has sold a \$100,000 lotto winning ticket and two \$10,000 winning scratch tickets. The \$313,373 Progressive Jackpot is the largest Fast Play jackpot won since the game debuted on April 23rd.

Wisconsin Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets over \$599 receive a two percent Retailer Performance Winning Ticket Incentive, up to \$100,000.



All or Nothing players can win the \$100,000 top prize by matching 0 of 11 numbers or by matching 11 of 11 numbers. The odds of winning the All or Nothing \$100,000 top prize are 1 in 352,716. Tickets are \$2 per draw. Drawings are held seven days a week, twice daily. Tickets must be purchased before 1:30 p.m. for the midday drawing and before 9:00 p.m. for the evening drawing.

The odds of winning the Fast Play Progressive Jackpot are 1 in 240,000. Printed on each Fast Play ticket is the amount of the estimated Jackpot when the ticket is sold and how much of that estimated Jackpot the ticket could win. The Wisconsin Lottery Fast Play Progressive Jackpot is only winnable in Wisconsin and is not shared with other states. Players can also confirm if their ticket is a winner by using the Lottery's new mobile app, available on the App Store or Google Play.
