## \$1,000,000, \$100,000 and \$50,000 Powerball Winning Tickets Sold in Grand Chute, Hayward, Green Bay and Appleton



The latest Powerball jackpot run resulted in several Wisconsin Powerball winners in July. Since July 1, 12 big winning tickets ranging from $\$ 50,000$ to $\$ 1,000,000$ have been sold at retailers across the state.

Powerball drawings are Monday, Wednesday, and Saturday at 9:59 p.m. Tickets must be purchased before 9 p.m. to be included in a drawing. Powerballtickets are $\$ 2$ per play, with the option to buy the Power Play feature for an additional dollar.

The odds of winning a \$50,000 Powerball prize are 1:913,130. The odds of winning a $\$ 1,000,000$ Powerball prize are 1:11,688,054 and the odds of winning the Powerball jackpot are 1:292,201,338.

The odds in winning a $\$ 100,000$ All or Nothing prize are 1:352,716.
For the $\$ 1$ Powerball Play add-on option, the odds of a 2 X multiplier being drawn last night were 1:1.75. Power Play does not apply to the jackpot. A $\$ 1,000,000$ prize can become $\$ 2,000,000$ with the Power Play. The Power Play multiplier for the $\$ 1,000,000$ prize can never be greater than 2X.
