## \$100,000 Powerball Ticket Sold in Luxemburg

**MADISON, Wis.** – A \$100,000 <u>Powerball</u> winning ticket was sold at **Kwik Trip** on 113 N. Main St. in Luxemburg for the Wednesday, August 9 drawing. The winning ticket matched four of five numbers (10-15-21-67-69) plus the *Powerball* (3). The ticket included the \$1 *Power Play* option turning a \$50,000 win into a \$100,000 win because of the 2X *Power Play* multiplier.

*Powerball* drawings are Monday, Wednesday, and Saturday at 9:59 p.m. Tickets must be purchased before 9 p.m. to be included in a drawing.

The next *Powerball* drawing is Saturday, August 12 where the estimated jackpot is \$194 million.

Players have 180 days from the draw date to claim their winnings. Information on how to claim a prize is available at <u>wilottery.com/winners/claim-prize</u>. All winning Lottery tickets need to be signed. Lottery tickets are bearer instruments; whoever signs the back of the ticket is considered the rightful owner.

Wisconsin Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets over \$599 receive a two percent Retailer Performance Winning Ticket Incentive, up to \$100,000.

For the \$1 *Powerball Play* add-on option, the odds of a 2X multiplier being drawn on Wednesday night were 1:1.75. *Power Play* does not apply to the jackpot. A \$1,000,000 prize can become \$2,000,000 with the *Power Play*. The *Power Play* multiplier for the \$1,000,000 prize can never be greater than 2X.

The odds of winning the *Powerball* jackpot are 1:292,201,338.
