## \$100,000 Powerball Ticket Sold in Luxemburg

MADISON, Wis. - A \$100,000 Powerball winning ticket was sold at Kwik Trip on 113 N. Main St. in Luxemburg for the Wednesday, August 9 drawing. The winning ticket matched four of five numbers (10-15-21-67-69) plus the Powerball (3). The ticket included the $\$ 1$ Power Play option turning a $\$ 50,000$ win into a $\$ 100,000$ win because of the 2X Power Play multiplier.

Powerball drawings are Monday, Wednesday, and Saturday at 9:59 p.m. Tickets must be purchased before 9 p.m. to be included in a drawing.

The next Powerball drawing is Saturday, August 12 where the estimated jackpot is $\$ 194$ million.

Players have 180 days from the draw date to claim their winnings. Information on how to claim a prize is available at wilottery.com/winners/claim-prize. All winning Lottery tickets need to be signed. Lottery tickets are bearer instruments; whoever signs the back of the ticket is considered the rightful owner.

Wisconsin Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets over \$599 receive a two percent Retailer Performance Winning Ticket Incentive, up to \$100,000.

For the $\$ 1$ Powerball Play add-on option, the odds of a 2 X multiplier being drawn on Wednesday night were 1:1.75. Power Play does not apply to the jackpot. A $\$ 1,000,000$ prize can become $\$ 2,000,000$ with the Power Play. The Power Play
 multiplier for the $\$ 1,000,000$ prize can never be greater than 2X.

The odds of winning the Powerball jackpot are 1:292,201,338.
