Check Your Mega Millions Tickets

Many Wisconsin players purchase winning tickets during jackpot run

MADISON, Wis. – Mega Jackpot! Tuesday was a big day for the Sunshine State. The largest jackpot in Mega Millions history, worth an estimated \$1.58 billion, was purchased in Florida, ending a run of 32 drawings.

Even though the jackpot was not hit in the Badger State, the Wisconsin Lottery urges players to check their tickets for one of the nine ways to win a Mega Millions prize. Before Tuesday's drawing, across the country, 62 second tier winning tickets of at least \$1 million and 967 third tier winning tickets of at least \$10,000 were purchased since April 21.

In Wisconsin, there were 900,144 winning Mega Millions tickets totaling \$5,627,722 in prizes during this jackpot run. Since July 21 alone, one \$1 million, one \$20,000 (includes Megaplier) and 11 \$10,000 Mega Millions winning tickets were sold throughout the state.

Drawing results are posted on wilottery.com and on the new Wisconsin Lottery Mobile App. Players can also use the mobile app to scan their tickets to see if they are a winner. In addition, the Wisconsin Lottery Player Club email reports drawing results, Monday through Friday mornings.

Players have 180 days from the draw date to claim their winnings. Information on how to claim a prize is available at

wilottery.com/winners/claim-prize. Players should sign their tickets as soon as possible after their purchase. Lottery tickets are bearer instruments; whoever signs the back of the ticket is considered the rightful owner.

Wisconsin Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets over \$599 receive a two percent Retailer Performance Winning Ticket Incentive, up to \$100,000.

Winning odds for Mega Millions are as follows: Jackpot, 1:302,575,350; \$1,000,000, 1:12,607,307; \$10,000, 1:931,002; \$500, 1:38,792; \$200, 1:14,547; \$10, 1:324; \$4, 1:90; \$2, 1:37. Odds based on one play for \$2. The prize money allocated to the Jackpot shall be equally divided by the number of plays correctly matching all 6 numbers.
