All or Nothing \$100,000 Top Prize Sold in Appleton

Evening drawing produces winning ticket

MADISON, Wis. – A player was perfect in Appleton. An [All or Nothing](#) \$100,000 top-winning ticket was sold for the August 12, 2023, Evening drawing. Purchased at **True North Energy** on 3411 N. Ballard Rd., the winning ticket matched 11 of 11 numbers drawn. The winning numbers were 1-2-4-5-7-8-9-10-11-16-21.

The big win is the first for True North Energy. Previously, the largest winning ticket ever sold by the Lottery retailer was a winning \$5,000 instant scratch game.

Wisconsin Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets over \$599 receive a two percent Retailer Performance Winning Ticket Incentive, up to \$100,000.

All or Nothing players can win the \$100,000 top prize by matching 0/11 numbers or by matching 11/11 numbers. The odds of winning the *All or Nothing* \$100,000 top prize are 1 in 352,715. Tickets are \$2 per draw. Drawings are held seven days a week, twice daily. Tickets must be purchased before 1:30 p.m. for the Midday drawing and before 9:00 p.m. for the Evening drawing.

Wisconsin Lottery winners have 180 days to claim prizes from the official draw date. Tickets can be claimed at the Lottery offices in either Madison or Milwaukee. The winner should call ahead (608-261-4916) to make an appointment so the Lottery can provide enough time to process the claim.
