## \$100,000 Powerball Ticket Purchased in Milwaukee

*Lottery retailer sells second big winning ticket in August*

**MADISON, Wis.** – It's been a great month for **Hawley Food Mart**. Located on 683 S. Hawley Rd. in Milwaukee, the Wisconsin Lottery retailer sold a winning \$100,000 [Powerball](#) ticket on Wednesday for the August 30 drawing. The winning ticket matched four of five numbers (4-13-35-61-69) plus the *Powerball* (4). The ticket included the \$1 *Power Play* option turning a \$50,000 win into a \$100,000 win because of the 2X *Power Play* multiplier.

It is the second time this month that Hawley Food Mart has sold a large winning ticket. On August 4, the store sold a winning \$30,384 [Fast Play](#) Progressive Jackpot ticket.

Hawley Food Mart is no stranger to big Lottery wins. In addition to the Powerball and Fast Play wins, the retailer has sold three \$10,000 winning scratch tickets in the last two years.

"Lately, a lot of people are talking about us as a lucky store," said Hawley Food Mart Manager, Pramod Patel. "We've had many \$1,000 winners along with the big tickets. Lottery is popular here."

Wisconsin Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets over \$599 receive a two percent Retailer Performance Winning Ticket Incentive, up to \$100,000.

Players have 180 days from the draw date to claim their winnings. Information on how to claim a prize is available at [wilottery.com/winners/claim-prize](http://wilottery.com/winners/claim-prize).

*Powerball* drawings are Monday, Wednesday, and Saturday at 9:59 p.m. Tickets must be purchased before 9 p.m. to be included in a drawing. The next *Powerball* drawing is Saturday, September 2, where the estimated jackpot is \$420 million.

Players can check to see if their ticket is a winner by going to [wilottery.com](http://wilottery.com) or by using the Lottery's new [mobile app](#), available on the [App Store](#) or [Google Play](#).

For the \$1 *Powerball Play* add-on option, the odds of a 2X multiplier being drawn on Wednesday night were 1:1.75. *Power Play* does not apply to the jackpot. A \$1,000,000 prize can become \$2,000,000 with the *Power Play*. The *Power Play* multiplier for the \$1,000,000 prize can never be greater than 2X.

The odds of winning the *Powerball* jackpot are 1:292,201,338.

The odds of winning a Fast Play Progressive Jackpot are 1:240,000.
