Holiday Weekend Includes Two Big Wisconsin-Only Lotto Game Wins

\$350,000 SuperCash! win in Waukesha and \$100,000 All or Nothing win in Suring

MADISON, Wis. – A pair of big Lottery prizes were won during the Labor Day weekend.

All the excitement took place on Sunday, September 3, when winning numbers were selected for the \$350,000 [SuperCash!](#) and \$100,000 [All or Nothing](#) top prizes during two separate drawings.

Sold at **Kwik Trip** on 21980 Watertown Rd. in Waukesha, the winning numbers for the \$350,000 *SuperCash!* ticket were 9-13-21-26-27-30, while the winning numbers for the \$100,000 *All or Nothing* ticket were 1-2-5-6-10-11-14-15-19-20-22. The *All or Nothing* ticket was purchased at **Martins Junction LLC** on 12470 Hwy 32/64 in Suring.

Wisconsin Lottery retailers who sell winning tickets over \$599 receive a two percent Retailer Performance Winning Ticket Incentive, up to \$100,000. Players have 180 days from the draw date to claim their winnings. Information on how to claim a prize is available at wilottery.com/winners/claim-prize.

SuperCash! is a Wisconsin-only lotto game hosting daily drawings seven days a week. The odds of winning the *SuperCash!* top prize are 1 in 1,631,312. Tickets must be purchased before 9 p.m. to be included in that day's drawing. *SuperCash!* offers two plays for \$1 and has a doubler feature at no additional cost.

All or Nothing is also a Wisconsin-only lotto game. Players can win the \$100,000 top prize by matching 0 of 11 numbers or by matching 11 of 11 numbers. The odds of winning the *All or Nothing* \$100,000 top prize are 1 in 352,716. Tickets are \$2 per draw. Drawings are held seven days a week, twice daily. Tickets must be purchased before 1:30 p.m. for the Midday drawing and before 9:00 p.m. for the Evening drawing.

Players can check to see if their ticket is a winner by going to wilottery.com or by using the Lottery's new mobile app, available on the [App Store](#) or [Google Play](#).
